### **Terms and conditions**

The offer will be subjected to the following terms and conditions

1. The items/equipment being quoted should be of OEM (original Equipment Manufacturers) and no non-standard equipment should be quoted. The tenderers must be authorized dealers/ distributors of OEM. A certificate from OEM to this effect should be attached with the bid.

2. Price alone will not be the criterion , quality will also be considered for purchase. The equipments must be delivered within 15 days from the date of order.
3. Tender should be addressed to the Principal, D.B.Pampa College, Parumala,Kerala, superscribing Tender for supply of instruments as per tender No.DBPC UGC XII/MRP/09/2015/1 Dated 3/09/2015. In the event of specified date for submission of tender offers being delayed a holiday, the offers will be up to the appointed time on the next working day and such bid will be opened accordingly.
4. Fixed price: The offer shall be on fixed price basis, inclusive of all taxes and levies. No price variation shall be allowed. Tender accompanied by vague and conditional expression such as “subject to immediate acceptance”, “subject to confirmation before sale” etc. will treated as being variance and shall be liable for rejection.
5. No commitment to accept lowest or any tender. The Principal, D.B.Pampa College, Parumala shall be under no obligation to accept the lowest or any other quotation received in response to this tender enquiry and shall be entitled to reject any or all offers including those received late or incomplete offers without assigning any reason whatsoever.
6. The tender should quote the rate of items in figures as well as in words. Inn case of any dispute/ambiguity in the rates quoted in words or figures, the higher value quoted either of the two shall be considered for evaluation of the bid.
7. The offer should be firm and open for acceptance till fifteen days from the stipulated date of opening. Price escalation will not be allowed.
8. Full details of business terms and conditions, (e.g. packing and forwarding, delivery period VAT/Sale tax/Trade Tax whether provisional or central) Other Taxes/Charges if any, the validity pedio of offer, discount, free delivery, packing or any other information relevant to the items may please be indicated clearly.
9. Full specifications, details and information regarding the articles to be supplied, such as make size etc. along with original catalogue etc. to be furnished with the offer. The list of users of goods of similar or same nature in the country should also be enclosed. The offer would not be considered fit if these details are not provided.
10. Normal terms of payment will be 100% payment within 30 dqys after receipt and acceptance of goods in satisfactory working condition after installation. Other terms of payment should be clearly spelt in the offer.
11. The tender should accompany 1% of the amount quoted as earnest money, payable to the Principal, D.B.Pampa College, Parumala which will be refund without any interest, if order is not accepted. In case of offer is accepted but not honoured by the tendered, the earnest money will be forfeited, if working information is given in the tender to influence the tender cost.
12. A preliminary agreement in a stamp paper of Rs.100/ must be attached with the tender form.
13. The tender should quote on their printed letter head paper, indicating thereon TIN and CST No., PIN, Telephone No., e-mail etc.
14. On site comprehensive warranty for all the items and works should be given as instructed in the schedule.

15. Performance of Bank Guarantee: the supplier should have to submit a performance security in the form of Bank Guarantee @ 2.5% of total order value from a commercial bank in the acceptance form within 21 days of issue of supply order. Performance security should remain valid for a period of at least 12 months beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier including the warranty obligation.
16. Tenders which do not fulfill any or all of the above conditions or incomplete are liable for rejection.
17. All other tender conditions in PWD manual is also valid here.
18. If 14/09/2015 is a holyday the next working day will be the last day of acceptance of tender.
19. Any or all tenders can be rejected by the Principal, D.B.Pampa College, Parumala, without assigning any reason and it cannot be challenged in any court.
